I disagree. The Virginia Freedom of Information Act contains the following provision:

For the purposes of the provisions of this chapter applicable to access to public records, [...] private police departments as defined in §9.1-101 shall be considered public bodies and, except as otherwise expressly provided by law, shall have the same obligations to disclose public records as other custodians of public records. Virginia Code §2.2-3701, "Public body".

Although Liberty University is a private institution, its police department is defined by VFOIA to be a public body and it is obligated to respond to a request for records. I urge you to reconsider your position.
