I disagree. The Virginia Freedom of Information Act contains the following provision:

For the purposes of the provisions of this chapter applicable to access to public records, [...] private police departments as defined in §9.1-101 shall be considered public bodies and, except as otherwise expressly provided by law, shall have the same obligations to disclose public records as other custodians of public records. <u>Virginia Code §2.2-3701</u>, "Public body".

Although Regent University is a private institution, its police department is defined by VFOIA to be a public body and it is obligated to respond to a request for records. I urge you to reconsider your position and to supply a response complying with the requirements of VFOIA within the required time frame.
